

TECH RIDER – FULL FRONTAL FOLK

Sound Equipment Needs:

3 vocal mics, all with boom stands (specifically for vocals, not instrument or utility mics)
3 boom mic stands
2 DIs
1 percussion mic with boom stand (for djembe, bodhran, dumbek)
XLR cables to go to sound board from DIs, mics, bass amp if needed (10)
AC outlet at front of stage for fiddle wireless system and possibly separate bass amp.

Monitor Needs:

At least 2 in the front—3 is optimal, but 2 will be adequate.
1 drum monitor. Depending on the venue, FFF plays with percussion only, or with a partial or full drum kit.

Sound Board/Mixing Suggestions:

1. Vocals (Stage Left to Stage Right):

Courtney/Delilah – Light/thin soprano. Needs volume boost.

Wendy/Fatale – Alto/middle harmonies. Medium volume.

Jen/Lolita – All vocal parts, depending on song. Very loud; needs lowered volume.

Please keep vocals warm and not trebly/cutting.

Vocals should be clear and understandable for talking—the band does a lot of speaking and song introduction during the show.

2. Instruments (Stage L to R):

Fiddle: natural tone is very trebly/bright. Keep high end/brightness low.

Guitar: has Eq and Volume control on instrument. Keep tone clear--not too bright or boomy.

3. Monitors:

We do not require 3 separate mixes in our monitors. We prefer to have all vocals at equal output levels so that we can all hear each harmony part. This is because lead vocals will change for every song, and sometimes throughout a song.

We like a lot of bass in the monitors (can be lower in the house to keep a good sound balance).
